

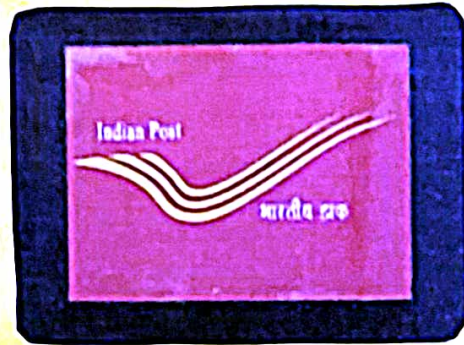

But for modern industrialization and pollution, these marvellous artworks are in the way of destruction. Therefore it is important to preserve the architectures before they turn to ruins.

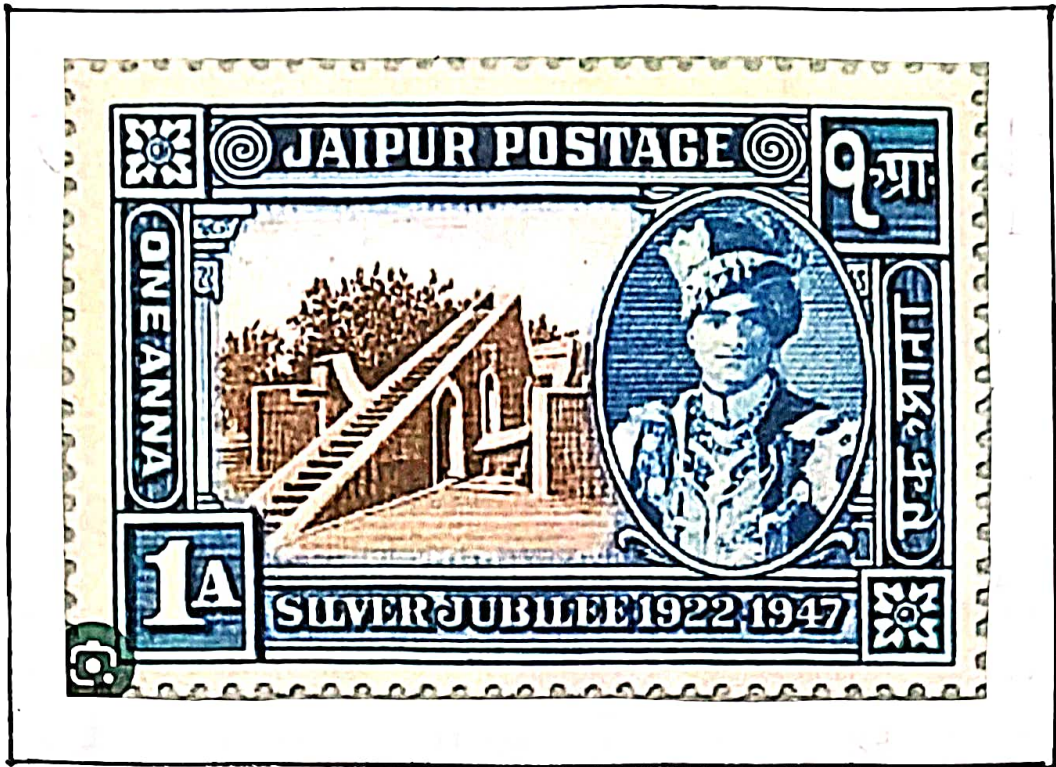

KONARK SUN TEMPLE

The word 'Konark' is derived from 'Kona' (meaning corner or angle) and 'Ark' (meaning Sun). The Konark Sun Temple is a 13th century CE temple famous for its fine and beautiful architecture with perplexed stone carvings. The stones were brought from the Hills of Khandagiri and Udaygiri and were interlocked with metals. The whole metallic structure was held by a magnet weighing more than 5 tons. The temple was constructed by King Narasimhadeva I of the Eastern Ganga Dynasty in around 1250 AD and is situated a few kilometres northeast from Puri Odisha. It has the appearance of a high chariot with huge wheels and horses carved out of stone and was dedicated to the Sun-god, Surya. This temple is called the 'Black Pagoda' and served an important landmark for sailors. The Hindus gather here every year for the Chandrabhaga Mela around February. It has been declared as UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1984. The Ashtadhatu Idol of the Sun God is never being worshipped as the chief architect, Bisu Maharaja's 12 year old son, Dhampada sacrificed his life into the River of Chandrabhaga by installing the Adhinanti (crown stone) and saved the 1200 workers from getting beheaded by the king who were working for 12 years and were not able to establish the Adhinanti on the temple. The Postal Department of India also released few stamps on this remarkable and one of India's finest stone carved temples.

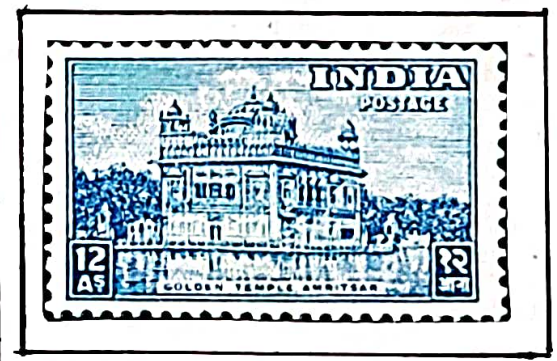


JANTAR-MANTAR

Jantar Mantar is a true example of Indian architecture and astronomy. The word 'Jantar Mantar' means "calculating instrument". There are total of five Jantar Mantars in India in the cities of — Jaipur, Delhi, Ujjain, Varanasi and Mathura (which is now in ruins). Out of these five, the Jaipur and the Delhi Jantar Mantars are the most famous. The Jaipur Jantar Mantar consists of 19 astronomical instruments built by the Rajput Ruler and founder of Jaipur, Sawai Jai Singh and was completed in the year of 1734 CE featuring the world's largest stone sundial. It is also recognized as the UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Observatory is an example of Ptolemaic positional Astronomy and featured three main classical celestial coordinate systems.

Jantar Mantar, New Delhi was built by Maharaja Jai Singh of Jaipur and consisted of 13 architectural astronomical instruments out of which the Samrat Jantar or the Supreme Instrument (a giant triangle shaped sundial consisting of a quadrant on its either side with graduations indicating hours, minutes and seconds), the Jayaprakash Yantra (it consisted of hollowed hemispheres with markings on their concave surfaces and was used to align the position of stars and sun in the sky), the Rama Yantra (used to determine the altitude of stars based on earth's latitude and longitude), Misra Yantra (consisting of five instruments which are used to find out the longest and shortest days of the year) are the four primary Yantias. Indian Postal Department has released few stamps of Jantar Mantar including the stamp of 9th Asian Games' logo of

Here are some more Temples and Architectures of India :-

i) Somnath Temple → Situated in Gujarat, it was attacked for 17 times by Mahmud of Ghazni and is also believed that the first of the 12 holy jyotirlingas emerged here.

ii) Taj Mahal → The marvellous marble monument was built by the 5th Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in 1631 in memory of his 3rd wife Mumtaz Mahal. It was built in Agra, Uttar Pradesh along the banks of Yamuna River. It was declared as UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1982.

iii) Golden Temple → It is famous for its golden dome and is one of the popular sacred pilgrims of Sikhs. The dome is made of 750 kg of pure gold.

iv) Sanchi Stupa → It is among the oldest free standing architecture with the history of Buddhism dating back from 3rd century BCE to 12th century CE. It is located in the states of Madhya Pradesh and is also declared as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1989.

v) Jagamath Temple → It is believed that Krishna's heart was placed here and the material that it is made from damages it so they have to change every 12 years. The Temple is located in Puri, Odisha.
